

## The hotel of the future

The [Puerta América](#) in Madrid is the hotel of the future. The hotel has been designed by a dream team of designers. A total of 19 big international architectural firms were engaged in this project. An exceptional hotel that is in a class of its own. Each architectural firm was responsible for one floor.



The hotel has a total of 12 floors with 360 rooms, a restaurant, garden and an [underground car park](#). Each floor has its own special character, but there are similarities as well. Several times a surprisingly futuristic design has been chosen, ranging from a white wonder world to movie star glamour.



The 7th floor has been designed by Ron Arad. A floor with movie star glamour: luxurious round beds, mirrors adorned with lights, round shapes everywhere and Bolidtop® synthetic flooring.
