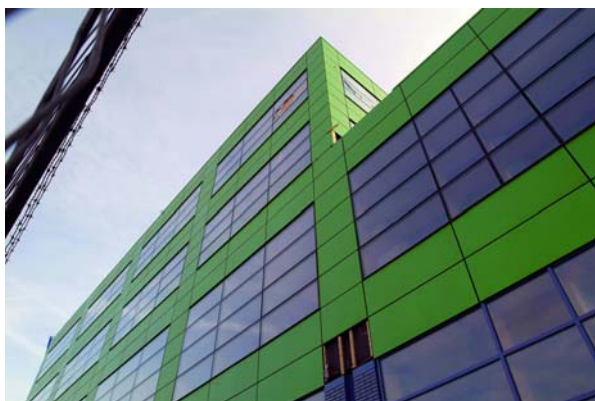


Brilliance in Amsterdam Osdorp



Halfway through the nineties, the first multipurpose schools in the Netherlands were opened. A multipurpose school is a co-located group of schools and organisations offering extracurricular services. The purpose of these schools is to increase development chances for all its pupils. In Amsterdam 78 primary schools are multipurpose schools by now.

One of these schools is located in Amsterdam Osdorp. In addition to two primary schools, the complex houses a day-care centre and a local health clinic. In the design of the building, architectural firm [Zeinstra Van der Pol](#) has paid careful attention to the functioning of each individual part of the building.

In addition to this, architect Liesbeth van der Pol had the idea to cover the exterior of the building with fluorescent green panels covered with multicoloured glitters. Bolidt gave Van der Pol the opportunity to translate this idea into reality in the [Bolidroom](#). Here she was able to experience the possibilities of synthetic applications for herself. The Bolicoat[®] Multicolor Exterior Shine system was developed in the Bolidroom. The multi-layer system has been purpose-developed for outdoor applications, like façade panels. The Bolicoat[®] Multicolor Exterior Shine system was applied to the panels for the school before they were invisibly mounted to the wooden structure of the building.

The result is a brilliant multipurpose school in Amsterdam Osdorp, both literally and metaphorically!
